A group of 3 - 6 artists from the Society of Sculptors (SOS) will be selected through a submission process of previous and/or proposed work. The Eichenlaub Director of Sales, Anthony Smith, will choose artists from those submissions.

Artists will work directly with Anthony and the marketing team at Eichenlaub to formulate a strategy to present your work, whether it is actual artwork, models, sketches, or proposals. *Pedestal pieces are encouraged*, as they can be set on a vertical stone plinth within the landscape.

Additional Information

Eichenlaub intends to promote selected artists through informational meetings or gatherings with clients utilizing digital technology and artist provided materials. Artists may be invited to participate in presentation gatherings at the Eichenlaub showroom in Millvale.
