- The submission of wall sculptures and pieces that can sit on bookshelves, ledges, and bookcases are encouraged – although not required.
- Please limit the use of small removable elements for reasons pertaining to child safety and library management.

Submission Selection:

Each artist may submit up to three pieces.

All sculptures will be juried from images of completed artwork.

Every effort will be made to include one piece from each member who submits work, however space does present some limitations.
